Summer School Immunization Requirements

Student immunization requirements are BASED ON THE GRADE LEVEL THEY ARE IN ON JULY 1 (For gradeless classroom - see instructions on the NYSDOH Immunization Requirements Chart)

Definition:	Academic instruction for students who have passed to the next grade level and are taking accelerated courses. Immunization Compliance:	Immunization compliance is based on the grade level at the time of entering summer school. For example: A student who completed 11th grade in June and is promoted to 12th grade in the school year beginning July 1, must meet immunizations required for 12th grade when entering summer school, though may attend up to 14 days without required immunization(s).	Immunization compliance is based on the grade level at the time of entering summer school. For example: A student with an IEP who is attending an ESY or yearround instructional program beginning July 1, must meet immunizations required for the grade they are promoted into, and may attend up to 14 days without required immunization(s).	Immunization compliance is based on the grade level at the time of entering summer school. For example: • A student who failed 9 th grade required course(s) is still considered in 9 th grade on July 1, and has already met immunization requirements for that grade. • Student promoted but making up a class must meet requirements for the new grade level (see Acceleration).	Immunization compliance does not apply to such programs. For example: Summer Enrichment Program Summer Recreation Program
