The New York State Center for School Health (NYSCSH or the “Center”) is a contracted Technical Resource Center for the NYS Education Department (NYSED) Student Support Services. Funded by and under the direction of NYSED, the Center has provided support to NYS school nurses since 1992. We are part of Monroe 2 – Orleans BOCES in Rochester, NY. While school nurses and school medical directors have been a focus of the Center’s support, the mission has always included all members of the Coordinated School Health Team.

In February 2016, the Center received an additional contract from NYSED to provide technical resource support and training to educators that deliver and/or oversee school health education. To provide this additional support, the Center added a certified school health educator to our staff in July 2016. This role provides resources and assistance to school health educators in the development of integrated, comprehensive approaches to school health and school health education to support students and enable them to reach their highest potential.

Is to ensure that school health services are effective in addressing the health, safety, and education needs of students by providing leadership and direction to school health professionals, parents, school districts, and community organizations.

- Continue to build, maintain, and sustain existing purposeful result-driven collaborations and partnerships at the national, statewide, and community levels.
