Reporting to School COVID Report Card will resume on 9/13/21

Hello,

As per Governor Hochul's [recent announcement](#), daily reporting to the [New York State School COVID Report Card](#) will resume. Beginning on Monday, September 13th, all schools will be required to log in and submit a daily report between the hours of 7am and 4pm on each operational day of the school year. Please note that some public-facing aspects of the [New York State School COVID Report Card](#) website are currently being updated; as such, survey data will not be displayed to the public temporarily.

The [daily school survey website](#) and all existing log in information for each school remains the same. If you have trouble logging in, need to set a designee to access the survey, or need a reminder on how to create a new survey submission, check out this [quick card](#) for troubleshooting tips. To reset your password, click the "Reset your password" link next to the "Log in" tab.
