The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) School Health Profiles Survey (SHP) collects data from a selected sample of middle and high school principals and school health educators.

The survey asks about school health policies and practices in the areas of health education, physical education and physical activity, tobacco use-prevention, nutrition, health services, parent and family involvement and community involvement, and school health coordination.

Data collected from schools is kept confidential.

The New York State (NYS) SHP is administered by the NYS Center for School Health (NYSCSH) on behalf of the NYS Education Department (NYSED).

The data from these surveys is used to:

- Inform and guide the revision of health education and physical education standards.
- Create and provide resources and professional development for school staff.

This document provides selected data from the NYS 2020 SHP survey and resources that can be used to educate school staff, families, and communities which will reduce health risks and increase student and school wellness initiatives.






Alcohol and Other Drug Use




